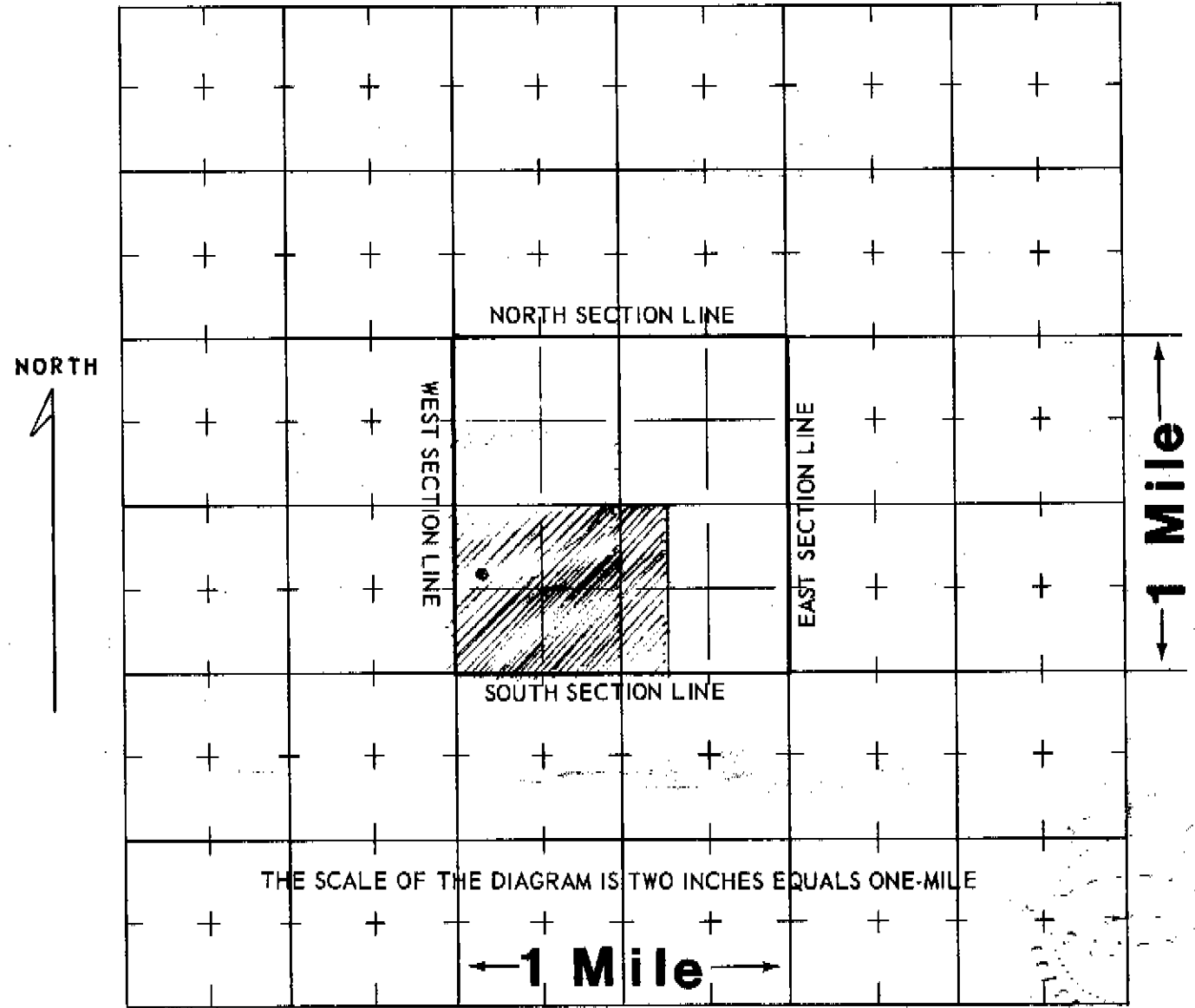

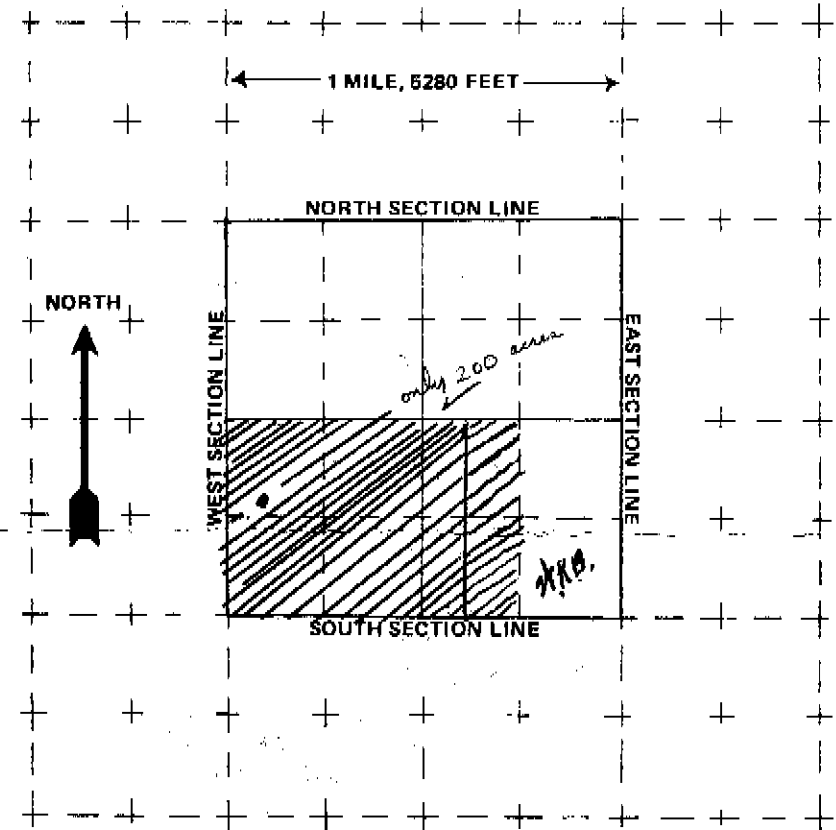

Dear Mr. Beedy:

On July 15, 1974, you were issued Permit No. 18607-F, located in the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 33, Township 27 South, Range 42 West, 6th P. M. According to our records, a well completion report for this permit was received on January 22, 1975; however, no evidence of beneficial use has been received by the Colorado Ground Water Commission.

C. R. S., 37-90-108(4) states:

"The procedural requirement that a statement of beneficial use shall be filed shall apply to all permits wherein the water was put to beneficial use since June 30, 1969. If information pertaining to completion of the well as required in subsection (1) of this section has been received, but evidence that water has been placed to beneficial use has not been received as of the expiration date of the conditional permit, the commission shall so notify the applicant by certified mail. The notice shall give the applicant the opportunity to submit proof that the water was put to beneficial use prior to the expiration date, but due to excusable neglect, inadvertence, or mistake, the applicant failed to submit the evidence on time. The proof must be received by the commission within twenty days of receipt of the notice by the applicant, and must be accompanied by a filing fee of thirty dollars. If the proof can be given favorable consideration by the ground water commission, then, within thirty days, a synopsis of the proof shall be published, specifying that objections shall be filed within thirty days. After the expiration of the time for filing objections, if no such objections have been filed, the commission shall, if it finds the proof to be satisfactory, find that the conditional permit should remain in force and effect. If objections have been filed together with a nonrefundable filing fee of ten dollars, the commission shall set a date for a hearing

on the proof and the objections thereto, and shall notify the applicant and the objectors of the time and place. The commission shall consider all evidence presented at the hearing and all other matters set forth in this section in determining whether the conditional permit should remain in force and effect."

Therefore, the commission must receive proof that this well was put to beneficial use prior to July 15, 1975, and the proof must be received within twenty days of receipt of this notice, accompanied by a filing fee of thirty dollars. A Statement of Beneficial Use form is enclosed for your convenience. If no such proof is received, Permit No. 18607-F will be permanently expired.

Dear Sir:

On July 15, 1974 you were issued irrigation well permit #018607-F at a location in the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of section 33, township 27 South, range 42 West, Prowers County, Colorado.

This permit expired on July 15, 1975 and you had not submitted your statement of beneficial use by that time.

On April 7, 1977, you were mailed a letter by certified mail, receipt number 434768 notifying you that your permit had expired and you had 20 days in accordance with C.R.S. 1973 as amended 37-90-108 (4) to submit proof that water from this well was put to a beneficial use before the expiration date.

On April 18, 1977, you submitted your statement of beneficial use stating that the water from this well was first put to a beneficial use on October 1, 1974.

We advertised this application in accordance with the above state statute and that you, through excusable neglect, inadvertence or mistake, did not file your statement of beneficial use on time. 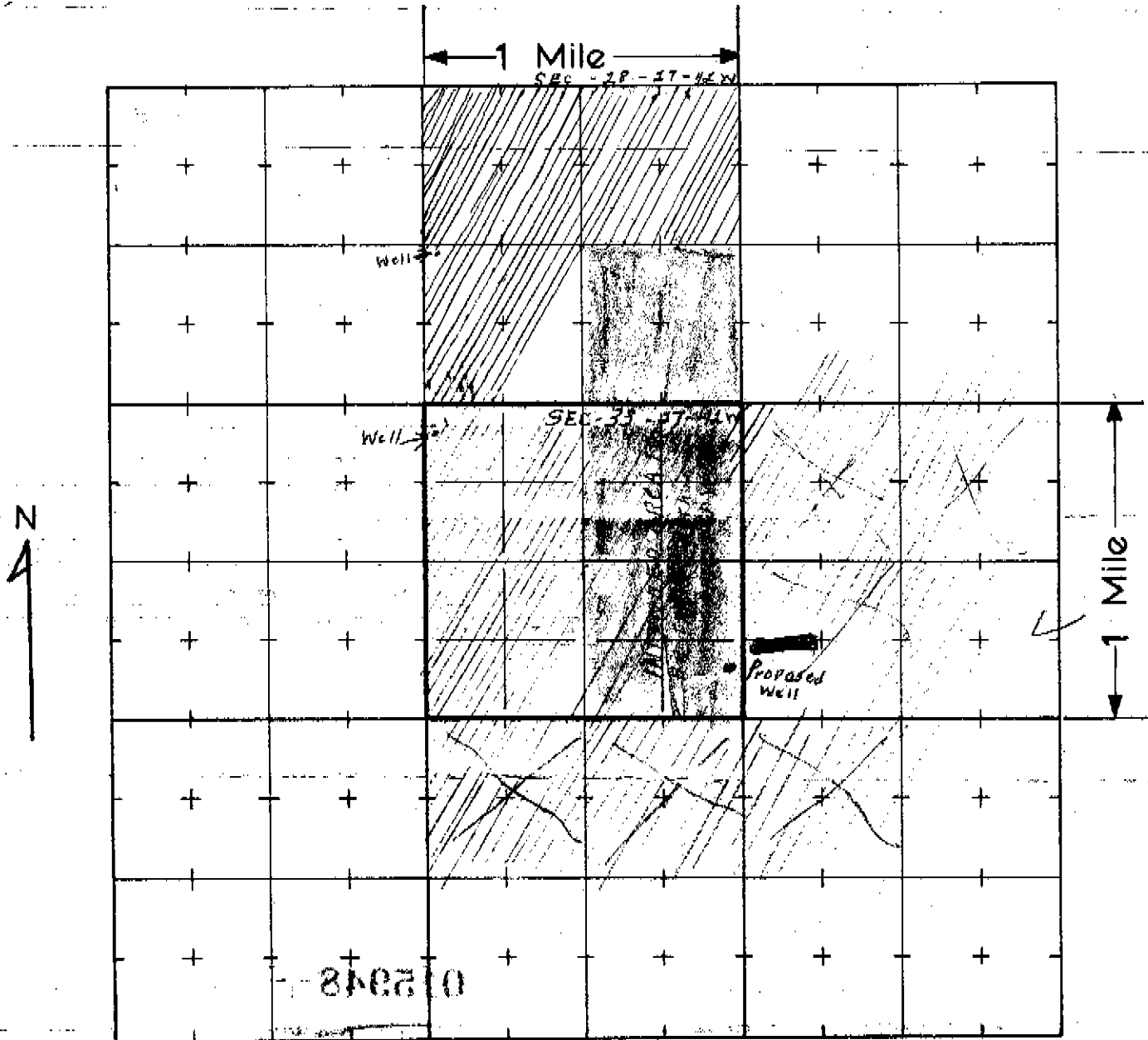
